

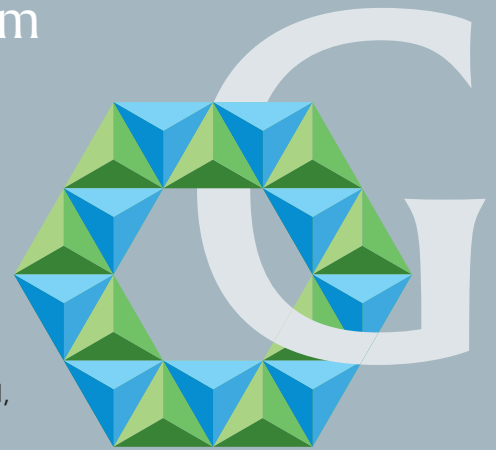

➤ Eligibility	Students who are enrolled in Hokkaido University's master's or professional degree programs.
➤ Structure	The program consists of Foundation Program and Honors Program. Their core courses are offered as Inter-Graduate School Classes (postgraduate common subjects) and each program can be completed in six months.

Requirements

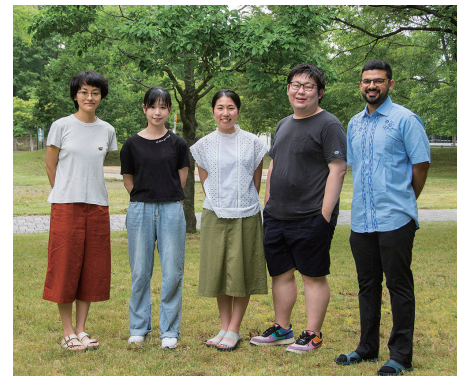
When submitting a statement of purpose, make sure to include:

You must take the TOEIC-IP Test. (reference score: 700 of TOEIC-IP)

Exam date: October 16 (Sat) from 9:30 to 12:40

*Available exemption: submission of official score report or equivalent and so on.
