授業の目標 Course Objectives			
<p>This course is offered as an Inter-Graduate School Class (General Subject): Humanities and Social Sciences “Issue solving exercise for real business I”. For the students of Nitobe College Honors Program: Graduate Curriculum, it is also opened as “Nitobe College Special Seminar: DEMOLA (Issue solving exercise for real business)” of Nitobe College Honors Program. Students will discuss a project with a team by demonstrating the “3+1 Competencies” (Ability for Sustainable Personal Development; Team Organization & Management Skills; Capacity for Knowledge Sharing & Application for Social Benefit; and Professional Ethics) learned at Nitobe College.</p> <p>This class is a program aiming at practical learning and acquisition of entrepreneurial thinking and action approach by utilizing the educational program of DEMOLA, which originated in Finland. Students receive instruction and experience in the open innovation method, which will be held at FMI (The Global Research Center for Center for Food and Medical Innovation) of Hokkaido University or online for two months. As a member of a team composed of students and business people, you will assemble a business problem solution model. If the submitting company approves the idea, it may result in a license agreement, etc.</p>			
到達目標 Course Goals			
<p>The objectives of this class are as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Through participation in the DEMOLA program, you will learn the cycle of designing, materializing, and verifying business models and acquire the habits of thinking and actions required to bring about innovation by accelerating them. (2) Learn an approach to planning highly accurate business ideas that lead to solving actual corporate issues. (3) Understand the social structure in which corporate issues are rooted and the future trends to be faced on a global scale and acquire methods to refine a business model with a more significant impact. (4) Understand the value of the team's intellectual property rights and learn the skills to manage and operate them.
