● Education to Foster the Mindset and Skills Required for Global Leaders

We provide education to acquire the "Five Competencies" (undergraduate) and "3+1 Competencies" (graduate) required for global leaders.



● Establishment of Autonomous Individuals and Enhancement of Specialized Abilities through Overseas Study (Undergraduate)

We necessitate overseas study to establish autonomous individuals with high ethical standards and rich humanity, and to acquire logical thinking and high expertise. [Scholarship programs support overseas study.]



● Provision of a Microcosm of International Society and Cross-Disciplinary Learning Environment (Graduate)

With a high proportion of international students, we realize a microcosm of international society in the classroom. Through collaborative learning with students from different specialized fields, we embrace diversity and acquire the ability to transcend specialized domains. [All classes and discussions are conducted in English.]



● Career Support by Fellows and Mentors

We offer courses involving "Fellows" (undergraduate) and "Mentors" (graduate) selected from alumni with extensive international experience. Through encounters with Fellows and Mentors who serve as role models, students have opportunities to reflect on the meaning of life and the significance of studying at university.
