授業の目標 Course Objectives			
<p>This course is offered as an Practical Entrepreneurship Education Program “Social Issues Problem-Solving Workshop”. For the students of Nitobe College Honors Program: Graduate Curriculum, it is also opened as “Nitobe College Special Seminar: Social Issues Problem-Solving Workshop” of Nitobe College Honors Program. Students will discuss a project with a team by demonstrating the “3+1 Competencies” (Ability for Sustainable Personal Development; Team Organization & Management Skills; Capacity for Knowledge Sharing & Application for Social Benefit; and Professional Ethics) learned at Nitobe College.</p> <p>This course is a practice-oriented program in which students generate business ideas to address real social and corporate challenges within a short time frame.</p> <p>Working in teams, students engage in the entire venture creation process—from understanding and analyzing complex issues to developing concrete business concepts. Throughout the course, AI tools specialized for venture creation are actively utilized to enhance efficiency and effectiveness in research, ideation, structuring, and validation.</p> <p>Through this intensive experience, the course aims to cultivate advanced human resources capable of designing implementable business ideas in environments characterized by high complexity and uncertainty.</p>

<p>By the end of this course, students will be able to:</p> <p>Analyze real-world social and corporate challenges from multiple perspectives and identify them as potential business opportunities.</p> <p>Develop solution-oriented business ideas through collaborative, team-based work.</p> <p>Effectively utilize AI tools specialized for venture creation to conduct research, ideation, and analysis efficiently.</p> <p>Synthesize business concepts within a limited time frame and present them logically and persuasively.</p>
